

At city's scale (600ha of naturban spaces) socially inclusive and strategic actions are proposed to champion a medium term nature-based vision of the city, changing forever how Girona understands, cares and benefits from its immediate natural surroundings.

Neighbour walk-shops, value mapping, dialogue with stakeholders and social labs are the main initiatives, facilitating a new governance model with the empowerment of stakeholders and citizens and the creation of a new naturban aesthetics through citizens experiential engagement. The Girona Alive Atlas, a collaborative digital platform, enhances community participation and prompts knowledge sharing

NATURE BASED DESIGN MANAGEMENT

A successive approach 80 Ha

At the medium scale, differentiated management techniques are tested in 80ha of the Pedreres Mountain with a low-cost, low-tech method to deliver 5 naturban parks. Co-benefits gained from the new green space connectivity include health and wellbeing, natural habitats and biodiversity.

The key issues are connectivity, the design of NBS by management, land mosaic diversity and climate change adaptation.

NBS interventions to the multifunctional green-blue infrastructure

23 Ha

At the scale of a pilot project in the peripheral and underprivileged Girona East district, 3 NBS (naturban park, constructed wetlands and riverbed improvements) are tested to reclaim green spaces for the neighbours, increase connectivity, habitat and biodiversity, water quality, health and wellbeing of the population and implement inclusive design with the creation of the Onyar River Park.
